6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 63 O.S. 2011,  
8 Section 91, which relates to the State Anatomical  
9 Board; re-creating the Board; and modifying the  
10 termination date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 91, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 91. There is hereby re-created, to continue until July  
15 1, ~~2012~~ 2016, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma  
16 Sunset Law, an oversight Board to be known as the State Anatomical  
17 Board, to be composed of the following members: The Deans or their  
18 designee of each accredited medical school and osteopathic medical  
19 school within the State of Oklahoma, the persons heading the  
20 Department of Anatomy, or comparable department, in the medical and  
21 osteopathic medical schools or their designee and two ~~(2)~~ persons  
22 appointed jointly by the presidents of institutions of higher  
23 education within the state which have educational programs other  
24 than medical which require on a regular basis human anatomical

1 materials, provided that these programs have been approved by the  
2 State Regents for Higher Education. It shall be the duty of the  
3 State Anatomical Board to designate agents to provide for the  
4 collection, preservation, storage, distribution, delivery, recovery  
5 from users, cremation and final disposition of all dead human bodies  
6 used for health science education and research in the State of  
7 Oklahoma. The Board shall elect from its membership a chairperson  
8 who shall perform such other duties as the Board may prescribe by  
9 rule. The Board shall have full power to establish rules for its  
10 government, to appoint and remove officers, and to appoint an  
11 executive director who shall keep full and complete minutes of its  
12 transactions and manage the affairs of the Board. The expenditures  
13 authorized in this section shall not be a charge against the state,  
14 but shall be paid by the agent designated by the Board to receive,  
15 store, issue, and cremate human anatomical materials. Records shall  
16 also be kept by the agent of all bodies received and distributed for  
17 the period of time authorized by the Records Disposition Schedule.  
18 The name of the oversight Board shall be the State Anatomical Board,  
19 hereinafter called the Anatomical Board. The Anatomical Board may,  
20 in its discretion, exempt any county, district, or institution from  
21 the provisions of this act in any calendar year for any length of  
22 time.
