5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to sunset; amending 53 O.S. 2011,
7 Section 231, which relates to the Oklahoma Music Hall
8 of Fame Board; re-creating the Board; and modifying
the termination date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 53 O.S. 2011, Section 231, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 231. A. There is hereby created until July 1, ~~2012~~
15 2016, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law,
16 a board to be designated as the "Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Board".
17 The Board shall be composed of seven (7) members who shall be
18 appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
19 Of the initial members appointed, two shall serve for two (2) years,
20 two shall serve for four (4) years, and three shall serve for six
21 (6) years as the Governor may direct. After the initial
22 appointment, all members shall serve six - year terms. Selection of
23 members shall be made from those individuals who have shown a
24 sincere desire to recognize Oklahoma's contribution to music.

1 B. The Board shall elect a chair and vice - chair from among
2 the membership to serve for one (1) year. Members of the Board
3 shall not be compensated for their services, but each member shall
4 be entitled to reimbursement in accordance with the State Travel
5 Reimbursement Act for expenses incurred in attending Board meetings.
6 The Board shall meet quarterly and at such other times as its rules
7 may prescribe. A majority of the members appointed shall constitute
8 a quorum for transaction of business. The Board may appoint and fix
9 the salaries and duties of an executive secretary or director and
10 such staff as may be necessary for the performance of its duties,
11 purposes and functions.

12 C. It shall be the function and main purpose of the Board to
13 honor those, living or dead, who, by achievement or service, have
14 made outstanding and lasting contributions to music in Oklahoma or
15 elsewhere. The Board may adopt such rules as may be needed to carry
16 out its duties, purposes and functions. Also, it may conduct
17 surveys and polls and may appoint such committees and
18 representatives as it may determine necessary or desirable.

19 D. The Board shall be responsible for selecting a suitable site
20 and/or facility in Muskogee, Oklahoma, which shall be dedicated to
21 the research, archiving and display of Oklahoma's musical heritage
22 and the individuals contributing to such heritage.

23 E. The Board may:
24

1 1. Solicit and accept donations, contributions and gifts of
2 money and property;

3 2. Expend funds donated or contributed for its support;

4 3. Acquire and hold real estate or interest therein or personal
5 property in its own name; and

6 4. Charge admission fees.
