6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending  
8 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-546.5, which relates to the  
9 Oklahoma Prenatal Addiction Act; expanding scope of  
10 disposition options; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-546.5, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1-546.5 A district attorney may convene a  
16 multidisciplinary team to assist in making a determination of the  
17 appropriate disposition of a case of a pregnant woman who is abusing  
18 or is addicted to drugs or alcohol to the extent that the unborn  
19 child is at risk of harm. The multidisciplinary team shall include  
20 at least one person with training and experience in the treatment of  
21 addiction. As used in this section, an appropriate disposition may  
22 include, but shall not be limited to, criminal prosecution of the  
23 woman or filing a petition for involuntary commitment as provided by  
24 Section 5-410 et seq. of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes to a

1 public facility or a private facility willing to accept the pregnant  
2 woman for treatment.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
