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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,  
8 Section 2-129, which relates to the compensation of  
9 inspectors, judges, clerks, and counters; modifying  
10 compensation of certain persons; providing an  
11 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 2-129, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2-129. The inspector shall be paid ~~Ninety-five Dollars~~  
17 ~~(\$95.00)~~ One Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$190.00) for each election and  
18 shall be allowed mileage reimbursement at the rate provided by the  
19 State Travel Reimbursement Act for mileage incurred to receive or  
20 return ballots and materials for the election. Judges, clerks and  
21 counters shall be paid ~~Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00)~~ One Hundred  
22 Eighty Dollars (\$180.00) for each election. Precinct officials  
23 assigned to work a polling place ten (10) miles or more from their  
24 home, shall be allowed mileage reimbursement at the rate provided by

1 the State Travel Reimbursement Act for mileage incurred from their  
2 home to and from their assigned polling place. An additional Two  
3 Dollars (\$2.00) per election shall be paid to each inspector, judge,  
4 clerk and counter of a precinct from the funds of the county.  
5 Compensation provided herein shall be paid for any state, county,  
6 municipal or school district election; provided, however, that  
7 compensation for elections conducted concurrently shall not exceed  
8 in total the amount herein prescribed. Said compensation shall be  
9 paid by the State Election Board for all regular Primary, Runoff  
10 Primary and General Elections, all statewide special elections and  
11 all special elections for United States Representatives or United  
12 States Senators and State Senators or State Representatives.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
