6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to technology; amending 62 O.S. 2011,
8 Section 35.3, which relates to the Information
9 Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act;
10 excluding the Grand River Dam Authority from
11 definition of state agency; and declaring an
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 35.3, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 35.3 As used in the Information Technology
17 Consolidation and Coordination Act:

18 1. "Appropriated state agency" means any state agency that
19 receives funding through the annual legislative appropriations
20 process;

21 2. "Information technology assets" means any equipment or
22 interconnected system or subsystem of equipment that is used in the
23 acquisition, storage, manipulation, management, movement, control,
24 display, switching, interchange, transmission, or reception of data

1 or information. The term shall include computers, ancillary
2 equipment, software, firmware and similar procedures, services,
3 including support services and consulting services, software
4 development, and related resources, and shall further include
5 telecommunications fiber networks used for conveying electronic
6 communication or information systems to multiple physical locations;

7 3. "Information technology position" means a classified or
8 unclassified position in the following functional areas:

- 9 a. applications programming,
- 10 b. EDP audit,
- 11 c. data examination,
- 12 d. computer applications,
- 13 e. computer data entry,
- 14 f. computer networking,
- 15 g. computer operations,
- 16 h. computer programming,
- 17 i. computer security,
- 18 j. computer software design,
- 19 k. web applications,
- 20 l. database analysis,
- 21 m. data management analysis,
- 22 n. database development,
- 23 o. database programming,
- 24 p. software design/development,

- 1 q. help desk,
- 2 r. imaging,
- 3 s. systems analysis,
- 4 t. systems application planning,
- 5 u. systems application,
- 6 v. systems administration,
- 7 w. systems coordination,
- 8 x. systems integration,
- 9 y. systems operation,
- 10 z. systems planning/development,
- 11 aa. systems programming,
- 12 bb. systems engineering,
- 13 cc. systems service specialist,
- 14 dd. systems support,
- 15 ee. network administration,
- 16 ff. network management,
- 17 gg. network technical,
- 18 hh. operating systems specialist,
- 19 ii. systems program manager,
- 20 jj. telecommunications, whether data or voice,
- 21 kk. software training, and
- 22 ll. technology development or support;

1 4. "Nonappropriated state agency" means any state agency that
2 does not receive funding through the annual legislative
3 appropriations process;

4 5. "Planned project" includes any major project or objective
5 included in the operations plan submitted by the agency to the
6 Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance as
7 required pursuant to Section 34.16 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma
8 Statutes;

9 6. "Shared services" means those state agency functions which
10 are or could be provided through:

11 a. the services and systems specified in subsection A of
12 Section ~~6~~ 35.6 of this ~~act~~ title, and

13 b. the programs, services, software or processes
14 specified in subsection B of Section ~~6~~ 35.6 of this
15 ~~act~~ title; and

16 7. "State agency" means any office, elected or appointed
17 officer, bureau, board, commission, counsel, unit, division, body,
18 authority or institution of the executive branch of state
19 government, excluding institutions within The Oklahoma State System
20 of Higher Education, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education
21 ~~and~~, the telecommunications network known as OneNet and the Grand
22 River Dam Authority.

23 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
