6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to county and county officers;
8 amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 178.1, which relates
9 to inventory; requiring certain inventory be
10 performed annually; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 178.1, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 178.1 The board of county commissioners in each county
16 of this state shall take, or cause to be taken, an inventory of all
17 working tools, apparatus, machinery and equipment belonging to the
18 county or leased or otherwise let to it or to any department
19 thereof, other than that which is affixed to and made a part of
20 lands and buildings, the cost of which as to each complete working
21 unit thereof is more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and
22 thereafter maintain or cause to be maintained a continuous inventory
23 record thereof and of like tools, apparatus, machinery and equipment
24 purchased, leased or otherwise coming into the custody of the county

1 or of any office, board, department, commission or any or either
2 thereof, and the disposition thereof whether sold, exchanged, leased
3 or let where authorized by statute, junked, strayed or stolen, and
4 ~~biennially~~ annually thereafter, or oftener in event of death,
5 resignation or removal of an elective officer with a term, to verify
6 or cause to be verified by count and report of the same as of the
7 end of a term of office and as part and parcel of the accounting
8 required by law of a retiring or re-elected officer, and, as to
9 appointive heads of departments amenable directly to the board of
10 county commissioners and as to quasi-governmental boards and
11 commissions such as free fair boards, hospital boards and the like,
12 the same shall be as of the last business day immediately preceding
13 the day certain commencing a new term of the board of county
14 commissioners; all in the manner as provided by law.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
