6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; requiring
8 certain information be included on low-point beer
9 retail dealer permits; requiring display of permit;
10 providing punishment for failing to display permit;
11 providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.7a of Title 37, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Every retail dealer permit issued by the Oklahoma Tax
18 Commission pursuant to paragraph 3 of Section 163.7 of Title 37 of
19 the Oklahoma Statutes shall have printed on its face whether it is
20 for consumption on premises, consumption off premises or both.

21 B. Every person who sells low-point beer at retail shall
22 post conspicuously and keep so posted at the place of business the
23 license required pursuant to paragraph 3 of Section 163.7 of Title
24 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 C. When a person violates subsection B of this section, the
2 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission shall impose
3 an administrative fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for
4 each day a violation occurs. Each day a violation is continuing
5 shall constitute a separate offense.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
