AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 18-114.12, which relates to the teacher minimum salary schedule; expanding minimum salary schedule; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 18-114.12, is amended to read as follows:

Section 18-114.12 A. For the 2005-06 school year, teachers in the public schools of Oklahoma shall receive in salary and/or fringe benefits not less than the amounts specified in the following schedule:

9     E. When determining the Minimum Salary Schedule, "fringe  
10 benefits" shall mean all or part of retirement benefits, excluding  
11 the contributions made pursuant to subsection A of Section 17-108.1  
12 of this title and the flexible benefit allowance pursuant to Section  
13 26-105 of this title from the flexible benefit allowance funds  
14 disbursed by the State Board of Education and the State Board of  
15 Career and Technology Education pursuant to Section 26-104 of this  
16 title. Any of the degrees referred to in this section shall be from  
17 a college recognized by the State Board of Education. The State  
18 Board of Education shall accept teaching experience from out-of-  
19 state school districts that are accredited by the State Board of  
20 Education or appropriate state accrediting agency for the districts.  
21 For the purpose of state salary increments and retirement, no  
22 teacher shall be granted credit for more than five (5) years' active  
23 duty in the military service, or out-of-state teaching experience as  
24 a certified teacher or its equivalent. Nothing in this section

1 shall prohibit boards of education from crediting more years of  
2 experience on district salary schedules than those allowed for state  
3 purposes. The State Board of Education shall recognize, for  
4 purposes of certification and salary increments, the years of  
5 experience of a certified teacher who teaches in the Department of  
6 Corrections' educational program beginning with fiscal year 1981.  
7 The State Board of Education shall recognize for purposes of  
8 certification and salary increments the years of experience of a  
9 Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor under the Department of Human  
10 Services if the counselor was employed as a certified teacher by the  
11 State Department of Education when the Division of Vocational  
12 Rehabilitation was transferred from the State Board of Career and  
13 Technology Education or the State Board of Education to the Oklahoma  
14 Public Welfare Commission on July 1, 1968.

15 ~~E.~~ F. The State Board of Education shall recognize for purposes  
16 of certification and salary increments all of the years of  
17 experience a:

18 1. Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor completed while employed  
19 by the Department of Human Services if such counselor was certified  
20 as a teacher or was eligible for certification as a teacher in  
21 Oklahoma;

22 2. Certified teacher completed while employed by the Department  
23 of Human Services Child Study Center at University Hospital, if the  
24 teacher was certified as a teacher in Oklahoma; and

1           3. Certified school psychologist or psychometrist completed  
2 while employed as a doctoral intern, psychological assistant, or  
3 psychologist with any agency of the State of Oklahoma if the  
4 experience primarily involved work with persons of school or  
5 preschool age and if the person was, at the time the experience was  
6 acquired, certified as, or eligible for certification as, a school  
7 psychologist or psychometrist.

8           ~~F.~~ G. The provisions of this section shall not apply to  
9 teachers who have entered into postretirement employment with a  
10 public school in Oklahoma and are still receiving a monthly  
11 retirement benefit.

12           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

13           SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
