6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to insurance; prohibiting certain
8 higher copayment or coinsurance for certain services
9 rendered by certain doctors; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6046 of Title 36, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 No health benefit plan, as defined in subsection C of Section
17 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall impose any
18 copayment or coinsurance amount on an insured for services rendered
19 by a chiropractic physician licensed under the Oklahoma Chiropractic
20 Practice Act that is greater than the copayment or coinsurance
21 amount imposed on the insured for the services of a primary care
22 physician licensed under the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and
23 Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act or the Oklahoma Osteopathic

1 Medicine Act for the same or a similar diagnosed condition even if a
2 different nomenclature is used to describe a condition.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
