5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2011,
7 Section 1210.200, which relates to the availability
8 of automated external defibrillators at schools
9 contingent upon funding or donations; requiring each
10 school district to make automated external
11 defibrillators available at each high school, middle
12 school and elementary school beginning with certain
13 school years; requiring each school district to make
14 automated external defibrillators available at each
15 high school athletic practice or competition
16 beginning with certain school year; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.200, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1210.200 A. This act shall be known and may be cited
22 as the "Zachary Eckles and Luke Davis Automated External
23 Defibrillators in Schools Act".

24 B. ~~Contingent upon the availability of federal funding or
donations from private organizations or persons made for this
purpose,~~ Beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, each school
district shall make automated external defibrillators, as defined in

1 Section 5A of Title 76 of the Oklahoma Statutes, available at each
2 high school site in the district. ~~The school district may also make~~
3 ~~automated external defibrillators available~~ and at each high school
4 athletic practice or competition in the district. Beginning with
5 the 2014-2015 school year, each school district shall make automated
6 external defibrillators available at each middle school in the
7 district. Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, each school
8 district shall make automated external defibrillators available at
9 each elementary school in the district.

10 C. Any school district that makes automated external
11 defibrillators available in schools or on school district property
12 shall be immune from civil liability for personal injury which
13 results from the use of the device, except for acts of gross
14 negligence or willfull wanton misconduct in accordance with Section
15 5A of Title 76 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

16 D. The State Department of Education shall develop and make
17 available to school districts a list of private organizations or
18 persons willing to make donations or that have resources available
19 to schools for this purpose, federal programs or grants, and any
20 other source of funding that school districts may use to purchase
21 automated external defibrillators. The Department shall also
22 provide public recognition for private organizations or persons that
23 provide funding to school districts for the purpose of purchasing
24 automated external defibrillators.
