7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
8 requiring certain counties make certain information  
9 available on its website; providing for codification;  
10 and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1901 of Title 19, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 On or before January 1, 2013, any county with a population  
17 greater than forty-five thousand (45,000) shall make available on  
18 its Internet website, or on a general website if the county uses a  
19 general website, the following:

20 1. The ability for residents in the county to pay ad valorem  
21 taxes on-line;

22 2. General and contact information for all county offices,  
23 including, but not limited to, the county clerk, court clerk,  
24 sheriff, treasurer, assessor, and county commissioners; and

1        3. Any information the residents of the county may find useful  
2 in interacting with the county.

3        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.  
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
