6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; granting all children
8 between certain ages the right to participate in
9 extracurricular activities in certain school
10 districts; providing for eligibility requirements;
11 providing for codification; providing an effective
12 date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 All children between the ages of five (5) years, on or before
18 September 1, and twenty-one (21) years, on or before September 1,
19 shall be entitled to participate in extracurricular activities free
20 of charge in the school district in which they reside. The
21 eligibility of an individual child to participate in extracurricular
22 activities shall be determined in accordance with school district
23 eligibility rules and policies which are applicable to all other
24 children.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
