5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
7 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.29, which relates to  
8 persons permitted to carry firearms; authorizing  
9 certain persons to carry firearms; and providing an  
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.29, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1289.29 Any United States Attorney ~~or~~, Assistant United  
15 States Attorney, or Law Enforcement Coordinator of the Office of the  
16 United States Attorney may carry a firearm on his or her person  
17 anywhere in the State of Oklahoma if the person has successfully  
18 completed an approved course of firearm training conducted by a  
19 certified firearms instructor which is equal to the minimum  
20 requirements for firearms training as set forth by the Council on  
21 Law Enforcement Education and Training.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
