6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
8 2011, Section 4258, which relates to the Ethics
9 Commission Act; modifying Ethics Commission Fund;
10 providing for funding based on certain fees;
11 providing for codification; providing an effective
12 date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 4258, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 4258. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
17 revolving fund for the Ethics Commission to be designated the
18 "Ethics Commission Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
19 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall consist of all copying
20 fees, lobbyist registration fees, ~~and~~ committee registration fees,
21 and any other fees authorized by law received by the Commission.

22 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
23 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Commission for
24 any expenses incurred in the implementation of this act.

Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the

1 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
2 Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4261 of Title 74, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 Funding for the Ethics Commission shall be based on a five-
7 percent fee applied to all funds raised by candidates, candidate
8 committees, and noncandidate committees payable within thirty (30)
9 days of the reporting period.

10 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

11 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
