8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to statutes and reports; providing  
10 for the Oklahoma Statutes 2011; repealing 75 O.S.  
11 2011, Sections 171, 172, 173, 174, 175, 176, 177,  
12 178, 179, 180, 181, 184 and 185, which relate to  
13 prior versions of the Oklahoma Statutes; providing  
14 for codification; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 192 of Title 75, unless there is  
18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The "Oklahoma Statutes 2011" certified by the Justices of  
20 the Oklahoma Supreme Court on November 7, 2011, are hereby adopted  
21 as the official Statutes of the State of Oklahoma and are declared  
22 to be in full force and effect. Provided, however, that this  
23 section shall not be construed to repeal or in any way affect or  
24 modify any special or local laws or any law making an appropriation  
or any law relating to any special election or validating act, or

1 any law affecting any bond issue or by which any bond issue may have  
2 been authorized, nor to affect any pending proceedings or any  
3 existing rights or remedies, nor the running of the statutes of  
4 limitations in force at the time of the approval of this section;  
5 but all such local and special laws, laws making appropriations,  
6 laws relating to special elections, validating acts, and laws  
7 relating to or authorizing bond issues, pending proceedings, and  
8 existing rights and remedies, and statutes of limitations running  
9 and in force at the time of the approval of this section shall  
10 continue and exist in all respects as if this section had not been  
11 passed. Provided, further, that this section shall not be construed  
12 to alter, change, impair, disparage, vest or divest, or in any way  
13 affect any right or interest in the United States, the State of  
14 Oklahoma, any Indian Tribes or Nations of Indians within the State  
15 of Oklahoma, nor shall the same be construed to repeal any act of  
16 the Legislature of the State of Oklahoma enacted subsequent to the  
17 adjournment of the First Regular Session of the Fifty-third  
18 Legislature of the State of Oklahoma.

19 B. The Secretary of State shall issue a proclamation and  
20 publish it in a newspaper of general circulation within the State of  
21 Oklahoma stating the date upon which the statutes were published.

22 SECTION 2. REPEALER 75 O.S. 2011, Sections 171, 172,  
23 173, 174, 175, 176, 177, 178, 179, 180, 181, 184 and 185, are hereby  
24 repealed.

1       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
