AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Administrator; providing budgetary limitations; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

5 SECTION 2. A. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law shall be set by the
8 Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

9 B. The salary of the Administrator shall not exceed
10 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2013.

12 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is authorized to:

13 1. Pay professional expenses of the Administrator of the
14 Authority, including dues, licenses, professional memberships,
15 continuing medical education classes conducted in the State of
16 Oklahoma, and medical malpractice insurance;

17 2. Pay professional expenses of any Oklahoma licensed
18 physician, including dues, licenses, professional memberships,
19 continuing medical education classes conducted in the State of
20 Oklahoma, and medical malpractice insurance, provided the physician
21 is a full-time employee of the Authority in accordance with
22 subsection B of Section 5006 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes or
23 paragraph 1 of subsection B of Section 840-5.5 of Title 74 of the
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1 Oklahoma Statutes and utilizing those professional skills in the
2 performance of their job duties; and

3 3. Employ six (6) full-time-equivalent attorneys. This
4 authorization shall not increase the budgetary limits in this
5 section.

6 D. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority for the fiscal year
7 ending June 30, 2013, shall be subject to the following budgetary
8 limitations, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions
9 of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 2012.

14 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
