AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Department of Health;  
requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting salary of the Commissioner; authorizing  
payment of certain expenses of Commissioner under  
certain conditions; specifying compliance with and  
providing for certain budgetary limitations; providing  
an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the State  
Department of Health shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

6 Receipt and expenditures of unanticipated federal funds awarded  
7 to the State Department of Health after July 1, 2012, shall be  
8 exempt from expenditure and budgetary limitations, provided that any  
9 such funds used for operations shall be included in the agency's  
10 budget work program.

11 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
13 upon the State Department of Health by law shall be set by the State  
14 Commissioner of Health. The salary of the State Commissioner of  
15 Health shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,  
16 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013. The State  
17 Department of Health is authorized, provided that the Commissioner  
18 of Health possesses a Doctor of Medicine Degree or a Doctor of  
19 Osteopathy Degree and a license to practice medicine in this state,  
20 to pay the professional expenses of the Commissioner of Health,  
21 including dues, licenses, professional memberships, continuing  
22 medical education classes conducted in the State of Oklahoma, and  
23 medical malpractice insurance. The State Department of Health for  
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, shall be subject to the

1 following budgetary limitations, except as may be authorized  
2 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
3 Oklahoma Statutes:

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 2012.

8 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
