AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Department of
Rehabilitation Services; requiring budgeting in
certain categories and amounts; providing for
exemptions from certain expenditure limitations;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
limiting the salary of the Director; providing
budgetary limitation; and providing an effective
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the State
Department of Rehabilitation Services shall budget all appropriated
and other funds in the following categories and amounts:

4 Receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded
5 the State Department of Rehabilitation Services after July 1, 2012,
6 shall be exempt from expenditure limitations, provided that any such
7 funds used for operations shall be included in the agency's budget
8 work program.

9 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the State Department of Rehabilitation Services by law shall be
12 set by the Commission for Rehabilitation Services. The salary of
13 the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
14 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013.
15 The State Department of Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2013, shall be subject to the following budgetary
17 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
18 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
19 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
20 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
