7 A Concurrent Resolution honoring the memory of S.M.
8 "Monsieur" Moore; proclaiming September 25, 2011, as
9 S.M. "Monsieur" Moore Day; and directing
10 distribution.

11 WHEREAS, the late S.M. "Monsieur" Moore, from his birth in 1903
12 until his death at the age of 91, was the personification of the
13 western pioneer; and

14 WHEREAS, for over 40 years, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore bred cattle
15 and horses on his 10,000-acre ranch near Dewey; and

16 WHEREAS, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore was a founding member of several
17 organizations and served as a director of the American Quarter Horse
18 Association from 1964 to 1979, as well as serving as their eleventh
19 president in 1961; and

20 WHEREAS, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore's influence was important in the
21 successful establishment of the Dewey Bank and many civic
22 organizations in Northeastern Oklahoma; and

1 WHEREAS, S.M. "Monsieur" Moore was an unparalleled blend of
2 horse breeder, cattleman, western pioneer, banker, oil producer,
3 civic leader and mentor to his family and friends.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
5 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
6 CONCURRING THEREIN:

7 THAT the Legislature hereby honors the memory of S.M. "Monsieur"
8 Moore.

9 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives does hereby proclaim
10 September 25, 2011, as S.M. "Monsieur" Moore Day.
