6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Concurrent Resolution relating to the Joint Rules
8 of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature; amending Rule 10 of
9 the Joint Rules of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature,
10 which relates to the legislative schedule; modifying
11 certain dates.

12 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of
13 Representatives adopted Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4 of the
14 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature which provides Joint
15 Rules for the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature; and

16 WHEREAS, Rule Eleven of the Joint Rules provides that amendment
17 of the Joint Rules must be accomplished by a concurrent resolution;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, Rule Ten of the Joint Rules provides the legislative
20 schedule for the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, including the deadlines
21 for Third Reading and Final Passage of bills and joint resolutions;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma
24 State Senate mutually agree that in order to provide for the orderly

1 consideration of bills and joint resolutions on General Order, the
2 deadlines for Third Reading and Final Passage of bills and joint
3 resolutions should be extended.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
5 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
6 CONCURRING THEREIN:

7 THAT pursuant to Rule Eleven of the Joint Rules of the 53rd
8 Oklahoma Legislature, Rule 10 of the Joint Rules of the 53rd
9 Oklahoma Legislature is amended to read as follows:

10 RULE TEN

11 LEGISLATIVE SCHEDULE

12 (a) The First Regular Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature
13 shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

14 1. March ~~17~~ 18, 2011, shall be the final legislative day for
15 Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the
16 chamber of origin.

17 2. April ~~28~~ 29, 2011, shall be the final legislative day for
18 Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the
19 chamber opposite the chamber of origin.

20 3. The First Regular Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature
21 shall adjourn sine die not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 27, 2011.

22 4. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both
23 chambers, a bill or joint resolution may be exempted from all

1 deadline dates in both chambers; provided, each chamber may adopt
2 rules which supersede the provisions of this Rule.

3 (b) The Second Regular Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature
4 shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

5 1. December 9, 2011, shall be the final date for requesting the
6 drafting of bills and joint resolutions in the House and Senate for
7 introduction for consideration during the Second Regular Session.

8 2. January 19, 2012, no later than 4:00 p.m., shall be the
9 deadline for introduction of bills and joint resolutions in the
10 Senate and House of Representatives for consideration on the floor
11 of the House of Representatives or Senate during the Second Regular
12 Session.

13 3. The Second Regular Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature
14 shall convene at twelve noon on February 6, 2012.

15 4. March ~~15~~ 16, 2012, shall be the final legislative day for
16 Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the
17 chamber of origin.

18 5. April ~~26~~ 27, 2012, shall be the final legislative day for
19 Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the
20 chamber opposite the chamber of origin.

21 6. The Second Regular Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature
22 shall adjourn sine die not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 25, 2012.

23 7. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both
24 chambers, a bill or joint resolution can be exempted from all

1 deadline dates in both chambers; provided, each chamber may adopt
2 rules which supersede the provisions of this Rule.

3 (c) This schedule may be amended or modified by the adoption of
4 a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the membership of each
5 chamber.

6 (d) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any joint resolution
7 introduced for the purpose of disapproving or approving agency rules
8 pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act.

9 (e) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bills introduced
10 for the purposes of incorporating and merging different versions of
11 a statute amended in more than one measure at the same or different
12 sessions of the Legislature as set forth in Section 23.1 of Title 75
13 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

14 (f) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
15 resolution introduced for the purpose of approving, disapproving,
16 repealing or modifying rules of the Ethics Commission pursuant to
17 the provisions of Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma
18 Constitution.

19 (g) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
20 resolution which proposes a special or local law and for which
21 notice of intended introduction is published in a newspaper for four
22 consecutive weeks pursuant to the provisions of Section 32 of
23 Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution.

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1 (h) The dates specified in this Rule for introduction of bills
2 or joint resolutions shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
3 resolution which contains an "RB" number pursuant to the provisions
4 of the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act. Such
5 measures shall be submitted to the legislative actuary not later
6 than such dates, and may be introduced not later than the first
7 Monday in February following such submission.

8 (i) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
9 resolution authored by the chairs and vice-chairs of the Senate
10 Appropriations Committee and the House Appropriations and Budget
11 Committee which affects the receipt, expenditure or budgeting of
12 state funds or funds under the control of an entity created by state
13 law.

14 (j) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
15 resolution authored by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and
16 the Speaker of the House of Representatives which is deemed by them
17 to be necessary for the preservation of public peace, health or
18 safety.

19 (k) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
20 resolution authored by the Speaker of the House of Representatives
21 and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate which provides for
22 redistricting pursuant to the 2010 federal census.
