7 A Concurrent Resolution commending the Fire Service
8 Instructors of Oklahoma and congratulating the

13 independent professional organization for fire service instructors

15 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Fire Service Instructors of Oklahoma
16 is to:

17 1. Provide effective and continuous leadership, education and
18 training of the fire service for the protection of life and property
19 against fire and related man-made or natural disasters;

20 2. Unite for professional benefit those members of the fire
21 service who share a sincere interest in fire service education as a
22 means of protecting life and property;

23 3. Provide an atmosphere for information and resource exchange
24 between emergency responders, instructors and organizations involved

1 in fire service education as a means of protecting life and
2 property;

3 4. Promote cooperation among private enterprises, nonprofit
4 organizations, associations and government agencies with an interest
5 in fire service education at state and local levels;

6 5. Disseminate state-of-the-art materials concerning fire
7 service education to the membership;

8 6. Encourage and support libraries of fire service training
9 material and their establishment by others;

10 7. Encourage research and special studies and develop training
11 and education programs and procedures, and analyze problems arising
12 and their application; and

13 8. Promote the importance of the role of the fire service
14 instructors in the total fire service organization; and

15 WHEREAS, this organization's motto is "quality instructors for
16 quality instruction"; and

17 WHEREAS, the organization has provided quality leadership,
18 training and education for over 30 years.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
20 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
21 CONCURRING THEREIN:

22 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature does hereby commend the Fire
