7 A Resolution recognizing February 9, 2011, as Rose
8 Day at the State Capitol; commending all citizens who
9 have come to the Capitol in recognition of Rose Day.

21 for Oklahomans, of whatever political philosophy or persuasion; and

22 WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives oppose
23 President Barack Obama's stance on forcing physicians to perform
24 abortions against their consciences; and

1 WHEREAS, on Rose Day 2011, hundreds of our fellow Oklahomans
2 took time out of their busy lives to come to their State Capitol, to
3 make a public statement, respecting the sanctity of human life, and
4 the worth of every unborn individual, and to speak with their
5 elected officials; and

7 greatly appreciate the heartfelt involvement of these committed
8 Oklahoma citizens, both young and old, male and female.
