7 A Resolution calling for a moment of silence; sending  
8 condolences and prayers to family of Jeffrey M.  
9 McCoy; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, on the morning of May 18, 2012, Probation and Parole  
12 Officer III Jeffrey M. McCoy was performing his sworn duties and  
13 mission of the Department of Corrections; and

14 WHEREAS, while performing such duties, a physical confrontation  
15 with an individual unknown to Officer McCoy resulted in his  
16 senseless and tragic death, and in an instant Jeffrey M. McCoy, a  
17 dedicated public servant, devoted son, loving husband and caring  
18 father, was abruptly taken from his family, his state and his  
19 community; and

20 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma joins the Department of  
21 Corrections in mourning the loss of Jeffrey M. McCoy, who has shown  
22 great dedication and service to the Department since December 19,  
23 2005; and

1       WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives, on behalf of all  
2 the people of Oklahoma, does hereby convey our most sincere  
3 condolences and prayers to the immediate, extended and correctional  
4 family of Jeffrey M. McCoy. He will be missed and shall always be  
5 remembered for his courage, devotion to duty and unselfish service  
6 in protecting the citizens of Oklahoma.

7       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
8 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

9       THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives calls for a moment of  
10 silence to pay our respect in memory of Oklahoma's fallen officer,  
11 Jeffrey M. McCoy.

12       THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives sends its sincere  
13 condolences and prayers to the family of Jeffrey M. McCoy.

14       THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the family of  
15 Jeffrey M. McCoy and to the Department of Corrections.
