6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to judicial compensation; rejecting
8 increase in judicial compensation; providing for
noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 Pursuant to the authority granted in subsection A of Section 3.2
15 of Title 20 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the six percent (6%) increase
16 in the compensation for members of the State Judiciary as approved
17 by the Board on Judicial Compensation on September 20, 2011, is
18 hereby rejected and shall not be implemented.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
