5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
7 Investigation; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 151.1,
8 which relates to the Internet Crimes Against Children
9 unit; authorizing the Director of the Bureau to enter
10 into certain cooperative agreements for the purpose
11 of appointing certain agents to assist the unit;
12 making such agents employees and commissioned law
enforcement officers of the Bureau; providing for
13 certain powers of the agents; providing for renewal,
14 suspension or revocation of the agreements; providing
15 that agents serve at the discretion and will of the
16 Director of the Bureau; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 151.1, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 151.1. A. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
22 (OSBI) shall establish an Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC)
23 unit for the primary purpose of investigating Internet crimes
24 committed against children, including, but not limited to, offenses
related to child pornography and solicitation of minors for
pornography, prostitution or sex-related offenses. The unit shall
additionally promote safe Internet use among children and their
parents by various media or printed-material campaigns or by

1 offering educational programs to schools or communities throughout
2 this state. The Bureau shall employ sufficient employees to
3 investigate and implement the ICAC unit.

4 B. The Director of the OSBI is hereby authorized to enter into
5 local cooperative agreements with local law enforcement agencies for
6 the purpose of appointing ICAC Affiliate Reserve Agents to assist
7 the ICAC unit of the OSBI. ICAC Affiliate Reserve Agents shall be
8 employees and commissioned law enforcement officers of the OSBI.
9 ICAC Affiliate Reserve Agents shall have general peace officer
10 powers throughout the state, including the authority to arrest, for
11 the purpose of investigating Internet crimes committed against
12 children, including, but not limited to, offenses related to child
13 pornography and solicitation of minors for pornography, prostitution
14 or sex-related offenses and to promote safe Internet use among
15 children and their parents by various media or printed-material
16 campaigns or by offering educational programs to schools or
17 communities throughout Oklahoma. The Director of the OSBI may
18 renew, suspend or revoke any agreement appointing an ICAC Affiliate
19 Reserve Agent at any time. Individuals serve as ICAC Affiliate
20 Reserve Agents solely at the discretion and will of the OSBI
21 Director.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
