6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation
8 Code; amending 29 O.S. 2001, Section 5-405, as last
9 amended by Section 1, Chapter 110, O.S.L. 2009 (29
10 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 5-405), which relates to
11 furbearers; allowing certain furbearers to be trapped
12 statewide; repealing bag limit for certain
13 furbearers; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 5-405, as
16 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 110, O.S.L. 2009 (29 O.S. Supp.
17 2010, Section 5-405), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 5-405. A. Except as otherwise provided, no person may
19 hunt, kill, capture or otherwise take or destroy any furbearer,
20 except from the first day of December to the last day of February,
21 both dates inclusive.

22 B. Any person who takes a pelt or pelts during the season shall
23 have ten (10) working days after the close of the season to sell or
24 dispose of the pelts or to provide written notification to the
Department of Wildlife Conservation that the person intends to hold

1 the pelts for later sale. Written notification shall be made on a
2 form prescribed by the Department.

3 C. The gray fox shall be trappable anywhere in this state and
4 the bag limit shall be ten (10) per season.

5 D. Nothing contained in these provisions shall prevent the
6 killing of furbearers actually found destroying livestock, poultry
7 or exotic livestock, nor the running or chasing of fox, bobcat and
8 raccoon with dogs for sport only. For purposes of this section, the
9 term "exotic livestock" means commercially raised exotic livestock
10 including animals of the families bovidae, cervidae and
11 antilocapridae or birds of the ratite group.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
