6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
8 21 O.S. 2011, Section 701.7, which relates to murder  
9 in the first degree; expanding scope of certain  
10 prohibited act; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 701.7, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 701.7. A. A person commits murder in the first degree  
15 when that person unlawfully and with malice aforethought causes the  
16 death of another human being. Malice is that deliberate intention  
17 unlawfully to take away the life of a human being, which is  
18 manifested by external circumstances capable of proof.

19 B. A person also commits the crime of murder in the first  
20 degree, regardless of malice, when that person or any other person  
21 takes the life of a human being during, or if the death of a human  
22 being results from, the commission or attempted commission of murder  
23 of another person, shooting or discharge of a firearm or crossbow  
24 with intent to kill, intentional discharge of a firearm or other

1 deadly weapon into any dwelling or building as provided in Section  
2 1289.17A of this title, forcible rape, robbery with a dangerous  
3 weapon, kidnapping, escape from lawful custody, eluding an officer,  
4 first degree burglary, first degree arson, unlawful distributing or  
5 dispensing of controlled dangerous substances, or synthetic  
6 controlled substances as defined pursuant to Section 2-101 of Title  
7 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, trafficking in illegal drugs, or  
8 manufacturing or attempting to manufacture a controlled dangerous  
9 substance.

10 C. A person commits murder in the first degree when the death  
11 of a child results from the willful or malicious injuring,  
12 torturing, maiming or using of unreasonable force by said person or  
13 who shall willfully cause, procure or permit any of said acts to be  
14 done upon the child pursuant to Section 843.5 of this title. It is  
15 sufficient for the crime of murder in the first degree that the  
16 person either willfully tortured or used unreasonable force upon the  
17 child or maliciously injured or maimed the child.

18 D. A person commits murder in the first degree when that person  
19 unlawfully and with malice aforethought solicits another person or  
20 persons to cause the death of a human being in furtherance of  
21 unlawfully manufacturing, distributing or dispensing controlled  
22 dangerous substances, as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous  
23 Substances Act, unlawfully possessing with intent to distribute or  
24

1 dispense controlled dangerous substances, or trafficking in illegal  
2 drugs.

3 E. A person commits murder in the first degree when that person  
4 intentionally causes the death of a law enforcement officer or  
5 correctional officer while the officer is in the performance of  
6 official duties.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
