6 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
7 21 O.S. 2011, Sections 1289.19 and 1289.26, which
8 relate to certain definitions and the wearing of body
9 armor when committing a felony; adding definition;
10 providing for enhanced penalty for use of certain
11 helmet in commission of certain crimes; and providing
12 an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.19, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1289.19. As used in Sections 1289.20 through 1289.22
15 and Section 1289.26 of this title ~~and Section 2 of this act:~~

16 1. "Restricted bullet" means a round or elongated missile with
17 a core of less than sixty percent (60%) lead and having a
18 fluorocarbon coating, which is designed to travel at a high velocity
19 and is capable of penetrating body armor; ~~and~~

20 2. "Body armor" means a vest or shirt of ten (10) plies or more
21 of bullet resistant material as defined by the Office of
22 Development, Testing and Dissemination, a division of the United
23 States Department of Justice; and
