7 An Act relating to the Grand River Dam Authority;
8 eliminating certain employee position; stating
9 eligibility of certain employee; providing for Board
10 of Directors to consider certain employee
11 specifications by certain time period; repealing 82
12 O.S. 2011, Section 864.2, which relates to the
13 director of investments; providing for
14 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 Upon the effective date of this act the position of director of
19 investments of the Grand River Dam Authority, as authorized by
20 Section 864.2 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be
21 eliminated. Any person currently serving in that position shall be
22 eligible to remain employed by the district, under the direction of
23 the General Manager of the Grand River Dam Authority with direction
24 relating to the employees' qualifications, duties and salary to be
determined by the Board of Directors of the Grand River Dam
Authority. The Board of Directors shall post and consider the

1 previously outlined items on the agenda at the next regularly
2 scheduled Board meeting following the enactment of this act.

3 SECTION 2. REPEALER 82 O.S. 2011, Section 864.2, is
4 hereby repealed.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
