5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to sentencing; abolishing mandatory
7 minimum sentences for nonviolent felony offenses;
8 providing for codification; and providing an
9 effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 12.2 of Title 21, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Notwithstanding any other section of law, and for convictions
15 occurring on or after the effective date of this act, all mandatory
16 minimum sentences specified in law for nonviolent felony offenses,
17 as defined in Section 571 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
18 shall be abolished, except for those provisions of the Habitual
19 Offender Act pursuant to Section 51.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
20 Statutes.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
