6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to county inventories; amending 19
8 O.S. 2011, Section 178.1, which relates to
9 inventories of certain property; requiring certain
10 annual inventories; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 178.1, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 178.1. The board of county commissioners in each county
15 of this state shall take, or cause to be taken, an inventory of all
16 working tools, apparatus, machinery and equipment belonging to the
17 county or leased or otherwise let to it or to any department
18 thereof, other than that which is affixed to and made a part of
19 lands and buildings, the cost of which as to each complete working
20 unit thereof is more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and
21 thereafter maintain or cause to be maintained a continuous inventory
22 record thereof and of like tools, apparatus, machinery and equipment
23 purchased, leased or otherwise coming into the custody of the county
24 or of any office, board, department, commission or any or either

1 thereof, and the disposition thereof whether sold, exchanged, leased
2 or let where authorized by statute, junked, strayed or stolen, and
3 ~~biennially~~ annually thereafter, or oftener in event of death,
4 resignation or removal of an elective officer with a term, to verify
5 or cause to be verified by count and report of the same as of the
6 end of a term of office and as part and parcel of the accounting
7 required by law of a retiring or re-elected officer, and, as to
8 appointive heads of departments amenable directly to the board of
9 county commissioners and as to quasi-governmental boards and
10 commissions such as free fair boards, hospital boards and the like,
11 the same shall be as of the last business day immediately preceding
12 the day certain commencing a new term of the board of county
13 commissioners; all in the manner as provided by law.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
