6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An act relating to state agency attorneys;
8 authorizing certain state agency attorneys to serve
9 as special assistant district attorneys or special
10 assistant attorney generals upon appointment by
11 certain officials; providing for codification; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 215.16A of Title 19, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A district attorney, upon approval of the executive director or
18 chair of the governing body of a state agency, may appoint any
19 attorney that is a full-time state employee to serve on a case-by-
20 case basis as a special assistant district attorney in a case in
21 which the expertise of the agency attorney would be of assistance to
22 the district attorney.

23 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 28c.1 of Title 74, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The Attorney General, upon approval of the executive director or
2 chair of the governing board of a state agency, may appoint any
3 attorney that is a full-time state employee to serve on a case-by-
4 case basis as a special assistant attorney general in a case in
5 which the state is a party and the expertise of the agency attorney
6 would be of assistance to the Attorney General.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
