12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 210, O.S.L.
14	2010 (59 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 5002), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 5002. As used in the Commercial Pet Breeders Act:
17	1. "Adult animal" means an animal six (6) months of age or
18	older;
19	2. "Animal" means a dog or a cat;
20	3. "Cat" means a mammal that is wholly or partly of the species
21	Felis domesticus;
22	4. "Commercial breeder" and "commercial pet breeder" mean any
23	individual, entity, association, trust, or corporation who possesses
24	eleven or more adult intact female animals for the use of breeding

1 or dealing in animals for direct or indirect sale or for exchange in 2 return for consideration;

5. "Person" means any individual, association, trust, corporation, limited liability company, partnership, or other entity;

6 6. "Board" means the Board of Commercial Pet Breeders;
7 7. "Commercial pet breeder license" means a license issued to
8 any person that qualifies and is licensed as a commercial pet
9 breeder;

10 8. "Dog" means a mammal that is wholly or partly of the species11 Canis familiaris;

9. "Executive director" means the executive director of theBoard;

14 10. "Facility" means the premises used by a commercial breeder 15 for keeping, housing, or breeding animals. The term includes all 16 buildings, property, and confinement areas in a single location used 17 to conduct the commercial breeding business;

18 11. "Family member" means the parent, spouse, child, or sibling 19 of an individual;

20 12. "Humane society" means a nonprofit organization exempt from 21 federal income taxation as an organization described in Section 22 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that has as a 23 principal purpose the prevention of animal cruelty or the sheltering

3 13. "Hunting dog" means a dog that hunts game;

4 <u>14.</u> "Intact female animal" means a female animal that has not
5 been spayed and is capable of sexual reproduction;

6 14. 15. "Kitten" means a cat less than six (6) months old;
7 15. 16. "Local animal control authority" means a municipal or
8 county animal control office with authority over the premises in
9 which an animal is kept or, in an area that does not have an animal
10 control office, the county sheriff;

11 16. <u>17.</u> "Marketing" means the solicitation for sale of animals; 12 <u>17. 18.</u> "Noncommercial breeder" means any individual, entity, 13 association, trust, or corporation who possesses ten or less adult 14 intact female animals for the use of breeding or dealing in animals 15 for direct or indirect sale or for exchange in return for 16 consideration;

17 18. 19. "Pet" means a dog or cat, including a puppy or kitten; 18 19. 20. "Possess" means to have custody of or control over; 20. 21. "Puppy" means a dog less than six (6) months old; 21. 22. "Registered breeder inspector" means an individual 21 certified by the Board to conduct investigations and inspections of 22 facilities; and

23 22. 23. "Sporting dog" means a breed group of dogs trained to 24 work with sportsmen when they hunt with guns or those dogs bred to

1	hunt or race including, but not limited to, greyhounds, sled dogs,
2	whippets, and dachshunds;
3	24. "Working dog" means any various breeds of dogs developed or
4	trained to do useful work, including but not limited to herding
5	animals, guarding property, search and rescue, and service dogs to
6	the handicapped; and
7	25. "Veterinarian" means a person currently licensed to
8	practice veterinary medicine in Oklahoma.
9	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5003.1 of Title 59, unless there
11	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
12	Hunting dogs, sporting dogs and working dogs shall not be
13	subject to the provisions of the Commercial Pet Breeders Act.
14	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
