6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to dedication of memorial highway;
8 designating the Sergeant Schuyler B. Patch Memorial
9 Highway; designating the Specialist Andrew R. Looney
10 Memorial Highway; designating the Specialist
11 Christopher D. Horton Memorial Highway; requiring
12 certain permanent markers; providing for
13 codification; providing an effective date; and
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 86th Street North to 96th
20 Street North within the Tulsa municipal limits shall be designated
21 as "Sergeant Schuyler B. Patch Memorial Highway". The Department of
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
23 on the highway bearing that name.

24 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 96th Street North to 106th
2 Street North within the Tulsa municipal limits shall be designated
3 as "Specialist Andrew R. Looney Memorial Highway". The Department
4 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
5 placed on the highway bearing that name.

6 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 106th Street North to 116th
10 Street North within the Tulsa municipal limits shall be designated
11 as "Specialist Christopher D. Horton Memorial Highway". The
12 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
13 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

14 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

15 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
