6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to income tax; amending 68 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 2355, as last amended by Section 7, Chapter  
9 136, O.S.L. 2007 (68 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 2355),  
10 which relates to income tax brackets and rates;  
11 deleting contingent change in top income tax rate;  
12 modifying the percentage of income tax levied upon  
13 certain income amounts during specified tax years;  
14 clarifying application of certain provision;  
15 repealing Section 4, Chapter 42, 2nd Extraordinary  
16 Session, O.S.L. 2006, as last amended by Section 13,  
17 Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2008 (68 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section  
18 2355.1A), which relates to income tax rate changes;  
19 and providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2001, Section 2355, as  
22 last amended by Section 7, Chapter 136, O.S.L. 2007 (68 O.S. Supp.  
23 2010, Section 2355), is amended to read as follows:

24 Section 2355. A. Individuals. For all taxable years beginning  
after December 31, 1998 and before January 1, 2006, a tax is hereby  
imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of every resident or  
nonresident individual, which tax shall be computed at the option of  
the taxpayer under one of the two following methods:



- 1 (1) 1/2% tax on first \$2,000.00 or part thereof,
- 2 (2) 1% tax on next \$3,000.00 or part thereof,
- 3 (3) 2% tax on next \$2,500.00 or part thereof,
- 4 (4) 3% tax on next \$2,300.00 or part thereof,
- 5 (5) 4% tax on next \$2,400.00 or part thereof,
- 6 (6) 5% tax on next \$2,800.00 or part thereof,
- 7 (7) 6% tax on next \$6,000.00 or part thereof, and
- 8 (8) (a) for taxable years beginning after December  
9 31, 1998, and before January 1, 2002, 6.75%  
10 tax on the remainder,  
11 (b) for taxable years beginning on or after  
12 January 1, 2002, and before January 1, 2004,  
13 7% tax on the remainder, and  
14 (c) for taxable years beginning on or after  
15 January 1, 2004, 6.65% tax on the remainder.

16 2. METHOD 2.

17 a. Single individuals and married individuals filing  
18 separately deducting federal income tax:

- 19 (1) 1/2% tax on first \$1,000.00 or part thereof,
- 20 (2) 1% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,
- 21 (3) 2% tax on next \$1,250.00 or part thereof,
- 22 (4) 3% tax on next \$1,150.00 or part thereof,
- 23 (5) 4% tax on next \$1,200.00 or part thereof,
- 24 (6) 5% tax on next \$1,400.00 or part thereof,

- 1 (7) 6% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,
- 2 (8) 7% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,
- 3 (9) 8% tax on next \$2,000.00 or part thereof,
- 4 (10) 9% tax on next \$3,500.00 or part thereof, and
- 5 (11) 10% tax on the remainder.

6 b. Married individuals filing jointly and surviving  
7 spouse to the extent and in the manner that a  
8 surviving spouse is permitted to file a joint return  
9 under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and  
10 heads of households as defined in the Internal Revenue  
11 Code deducting federal income tax:

- 12 (1) 1/2% tax on the first \$2,000.00 or part thereof,
- 13 (2) 1% tax on the next \$3,000.00 or part thereof,
- 14 (3) 2% tax on the next \$2,500.00 or part thereof,
- 15 (4) 3% tax on the next \$1,400.00 or part thereof,
- 16 (5) 4% tax on the next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,
- 17 (6) 5% tax on the next \$1,600.00 or part thereof,
- 18 (7) 6% tax on the next \$1,250.00 or part thereof,
- 19 (8) 7% tax on the next \$1,750.00 or part thereof,
- 20 (9) 8% tax on the next \$3,000.00 or part thereof,
- 21 (10) 9% tax on the next \$6,000.00 or part thereof, and
- 22 (11) 10% tax on the remainder.

23 B. 1. Individuals. For all taxable years beginning on or  
24 after January 1, 2008, and before January 1, 2012, a tax is hereby

1 imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of every resident or  
2 nonresident individual, which tax shall be computed as follows:

1        2. Individuals. For the taxable year beginning on January 1,  
2 2012, a tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of  
3 every resident or nonresident individual, which tax shall be  
4 computed as follows:

5        a. Single individuals and married individuals filing  
6 separately:

7            (1) 1/2% tax on first \$1,000.00 or part thereof,

8            (2) 1% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,

9            (3) 2% tax on next \$1,250.00 or part thereof,

10           (4) 3% tax on next \$1,150.00 or part thereof,

11           (5) 4% tax on next \$2,300.00 or part thereof, and

12           (6) 4.5% tax on the remainder.

13        b. Married individuals filing jointly and surviving  
14 spouse to the extent and in the manner that a  
15 surviving spouse is permitted to file a joint return  
16 under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and  
17 heads of households as defined in the Internal Revenue  
18 Code:

19           (1) 1/2% tax on first \$2,000.00 or part thereof,

20           (2) 1% tax on next \$3,000.00 or part thereof,

21           (3) 2% tax on next \$2,500.00 or part thereof,

22           (4) 3% tax on next \$2,300.00 or part thereof,

23           (5) 4% tax on next \$2,400.00 or part thereof, and

24           (6) 4.5% tax on the remainder.

1       3. Individuals. For the taxable year beginning on January 1,  
2 2013, a tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of  
3 every resident or nonresident individual, which tax shall be  
4 computed as follows:

5       a. Single individuals and married individuals filing  
6 separately:

7           (1) 1/2% tax on first \$1,000.00 or part thereof,

8           (2) 1% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,

9           (3) 2% tax on next \$1,250.00 or part thereof,

10          (4) 3% tax on next \$1,150.00 or part thereof, and

11          (5) 3.5% tax on the remainder.

12       b. Married individuals filing jointly and surviving  
13 spouse to the extent and in the manner that a  
14 surviving spouse is permitted to file a joint return  
15 under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and  
16 heads of households as defined in the Internal Revenue  
17 Code:

18           (1) 1/2% tax on first \$2,000.00 or part thereof,

19           (2) 1% tax on next \$3,000.00 or part thereof,

20           (3) 2% tax on next \$2,500.00 or part thereof,

21           (4) 3% tax on next \$2,300.00 or part thereof, and

22           (5) 3.5% tax on the remainder.

23       4. Individuals. For the taxable year beginning on January 1,  
24 2014, a tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of

1 every resident or nonresident individual, which tax shall be  
2 computed as follows:

3 a. Single individuals and married individuals filing  
4 separately:

5 (1) 1/2% tax on first \$1,000.00 or part thereof,

6 (2) 1% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,

7 (3) 2% tax on next \$1,250.00 or part thereof, and

8 (4) 2.5% tax on the remainder.

9 b. Married individuals filing jointly and surviving

10 spouse to the extent and in the manner that a

11 surviving spouse is permitted to file a joint return

12 under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and

13 heads of households as defined in the Internal Revenue

14 Code:

15 (1) 1/2% tax on first \$2,000.00 or part thereof,

16 (2) 1% tax on next \$3,000.00 or part thereof,

17 (3) 2% tax on next \$2,500.00 or part thereof, and

18 (4) 2.5% tax on the remainder.

19 5. Individuals. For the taxable year beginning on January 1,

20 2015, a tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of

21 every resident or nonresident individual, which tax shall be

22 computed as follows:

23 a. Single individuals and married individuals filing

24 separately:

- 1           (1) 1/2% tax on first \$1,000.00 or part thereof,  
2           (2) 1% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof, and  
3           (3) 1.5% tax on the remainder.

4           b. Married individuals filing jointly and surviving  
5           spouse to the extent and in the manner that a  
6           surviving spouse is permitted to file a joint return  
7           under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and  
8           heads of households as defined in the Internal Revenue  
9           Code:

- 10           (1) 1/2% tax on first \$2,000.00 or part thereof,  
11           (2) 1% tax on next \$3,000.00 or part thereof, and  
12           (3) 1.5% tax on the remainder.

13           6. Individuals. For all taxable years beginning on or after  
14           January 1, 2016, no tax shall be imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable  
15           income of every resident or nonresident individual.

16           No deduction for federal income taxes paid shall be allowed to  
17 any taxpayer to arrive at taxable income for those tax years when a  
18 tax is imposed pursuant to paragraphs 1 through 5 of this  
19 subsection.

20           C. Nonresident aliens. In lieu of the rates set forth in  
21 subsection A above, there shall be imposed on nonresident aliens, as  
22 defined in the Internal Revenue Code, a tax of eight percent (8%)  
23 instead of thirty percent (30%) as used in the Internal Revenue  
24 Code, with respect to the Oklahoma taxable income of such

1 nonresident aliens as determined under the provision of the Oklahoma  
2 Income Tax Act.

3       Every payer of amounts covered by this subsection shall deduct  
4 and withhold from such amounts paid each payee an amount equal to  
5 eight percent (8%) thereof. Every payer required to deduct and  
6 withhold taxes under this subsection shall for each quarterly period  
7 on or before the last day of the month following the close of each  
8 such quarterly period, pay over the amount so withheld as taxes to  
9 the Tax Commission, and shall file a return with each such payment.  
10 Such return shall be in such form as the Tax Commission shall  
11 prescribe. Every payer required under this subsection to deduct and  
12 withhold a tax from a payee shall, as to the total amounts paid to  
13 each payee during the calendar year, furnish to such payee, on or  
14 before January 31, of the succeeding year, a written statement  
15 showing the name of the payer, the name of the payee and the payee's  
16 social security account number, if any, the total amount paid  
17 subject to taxation, and the total amount deducted and withheld as  
18 tax and such other information as the Tax Commission may require.  
19 Any payer who fails to withhold or pay to the Tax Commission any  
20 sums herein required to be withheld or paid shall be personally and  
21 individually liable therefor to the State of Oklahoma.

22       D. Corporations. For all taxable years beginning after  
23 December 31, 1989, a tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable  
24 income of every corporation doing business within this state or

1 deriving income from sources within this state in an amount equal to  
2 six percent (6%) thereof.

3 There shall be no additional Oklahoma income tax imposed on  
4 accumulated taxable income or on undistributed personal holding  
5 company income as those terms are defined in the Internal Revenue  
6 Code.

7 E. Certain foreign corporations. In lieu of the tax imposed in  
8 the first paragraph of subsection C of this section, for all taxable  
9 years beginning after December 31, 1989, there shall be imposed on  
10 foreign corporations, as defined in the Internal Revenue Code, a tax  
11 of six percent (6%) instead of thirty percent (30%) as used in the  
12 Internal Revenue Code, where such income is received from sources  
13 within Oklahoma, in accordance with the provisions of the Internal  
14 Revenue Code and the Oklahoma Income Tax Act.

15 Every payer of amounts covered by this subsection shall deduct  
16 and withhold from such amounts paid each payee an amount equal to  
17 six percent (6%) thereof. Every payer required to deduct and  
18 withhold taxes under this subsection shall for each quarterly period  
19 on or before the last day of the month following the close of each  
20 such quarterly period, pay over the amount so withheld as taxes to  
21 the Tax Commission, and shall file a return with each such payment.  
22 Such return shall be in such form as the Tax Commission shall  
23 prescribe. Every payer required under this subsection to deduct and  
24 withhold a tax from a payee shall, as to the total amounts paid to

1 each payee during the calendar year, furnish to such payee, on or  
2 before January 31, of the succeeding year, a written statement  
3 showing the name of the payer, the name of the payee and the payee's  
4 social security account number, if any, the total amounts paid  
5 subject to taxation, the total amount deducted and withheld as tax  
6 and such other information as the Tax Commission may require. Any  
7 payer who fails to withhold or pay to the Tax Commission any sums  
8 herein required to be withheld or paid shall be personally and  
9 individually liable therefor to the State of Oklahoma.

10 F. Fiduciaries. A tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma  
11 taxable income of every trust and estate at the same rates as are  
12 provided in subsection B of this section for single individuals.  
13 Fiduciaries are not allowed a deduction for any federal income tax  
14 paid.

15 G. Tax rate tables. For all taxable years beginning after  
16 December 31, 1991, in lieu of the tax imposed by subsection A or B  
17 of this section, as applicable there is hereby imposed for each  
18 taxable year on the taxable income of every individual, whose  
19 taxable income for such taxable year does not exceed the ceiling  
20 amount, a tax determined under tables, applicable to such taxable  
21 year which shall be prescribed by the Tax Commission and which shall  
22 be in such form as it determines appropriate. In the table so  
23 prescribed, the amounts of the tax shall be computed on the basis of  
24 the rates prescribed by subsections A and B of this section. For

1 purposes of this subsection, the term "ceiling amount" means, with  
2 respect to any taxpayer, the amount determined by the Tax Commission  
3 for the tax rate category in which such taxpayer falls.

4 SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 4, Chapter 42, 2nd  
5 Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 2006, as last amended by Section 13,  
6 Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2008 (68 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 2355.1A), is  
7 hereby repealed.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
