6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to traffic violations; creating the  
8 Mallory Jones Child Safety Act; providing short  
9 title; directing issuance of fine under certain  
10 circumstances; providing for codification; providing  
11 for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Mallory Jones  
16 Child Safety Act".

17 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-1120 of Title 47, unless  
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Any person operating a motor vehicle and issued a citation  
21 pursuant to a moving traffic violation as authorized by law,  
22 excluding any parking and standing violations, who is transporting  
23 another person under eighteen (18) years of age, shall be issued a  
24

1 traffic citation in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each  
2 person under eighteen (18) years of age riding as a passenger of the  
3 motor vehicle. The citation created by this section shall exclude  
4 the driver, if applicable.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
