6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Art in Public Places
8 Act; amending Sections 7 and 8, Chapter 254, O.S.L.
9 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2010, Sections 9030.6 and
10 9030.7), which relate to the Commissioning of Art in
11 Public Places Revolving Fund and the Art in Public
12 Places Administrative and Maintenance Revolving Fund;
13 making funds inoperable upon certain event; repealing
14 Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 2004
15 and Section 6, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 2004, as amended
16 by Section 2, Chapter 400, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp.
17 2010, Sections 9030, 9030.1, 9030.2, 9030.3, 9030.4
18 and 9030.5), which relate to the Oklahoma Art in
19 Public Places Act; and declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 7, Chapter 254, O.S.L.
22 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 9030.6), is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 Section 9030.6 A. 1. There is hereby created in the State
Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Historical Society to be
designated the "Commissioning of Art in Public Places Revolving
Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the

1 Society from the sources provided for in Section ~~6~~ 9030.5 of this
2 ~~act~~ title.

3 2. The Society shall establish a separate subaccount for each
4 project. Monies in these subaccounts may be used to match monies
5 from other private and public sources for commissioning art in
6 accordance with the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act.

7 3. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
8 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
9 Historical Society for the commissioning of art and insurance for
10 the art in accordance with the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act.

11 4. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
12 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
13 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

14 B. If there are monies from a project for the commissioning of
15 art not spent, those monies may be pooled in the fund for the
16 commissioning of art in, on, or near other state buildings.

17 C. The fund shall cease to exist upon the expenditure of any
18 monies that accrued to the fund prior to the effective date of this
19 act.

20 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 8, Chapter 254, O.S.L.
21 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 9030.7), is amended to read as
22 follows:

23 Section 9030.7 A. 1. There is hereby created in the State
24 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Historical Society to be

1 designated the "Art in Public Places Administrative and Maintenance
2 Revolving Fund". All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are
3 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Society.
4 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
5 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Society
6 from the sources provided for in Section ~~6~~ 9030.5 of this ~~act~~ title.

7 2. This fund shall consist of two subaccounts, one account for
8 maintenance and repair purposes and one account for administrative
9 and education purposes. Monies accruing to the credit of the
10 subaccount for maintenance and repair shall be used for the purpose
11 of restoring art in all state public buildings including, but not
12 limited to, public buildings at institutions within The Oklahoma
13 State System of Higher Education.

14 3. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
15 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
16 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

17 B. Whenever the unencumbered balance in this fund exceeds One
18 Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), the assessment shall be placed in
19 the Commissioning of Art in Public Places Revolving Fund to the
20 credit of the subaccount established for the project upon which the
21 assessment was made.

22 C. The fund shall cease to exist upon the expenditure of any
23 monies that accrued to the fund prior to the effective date of this
24 act.

1 SECTION 3. REPEALER Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Chapter
2 254, O.S.L. 2004 and Section 6, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 2004, as amended
3 by Section 2, Chapter 400, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2010, Sections
4 9030, 9030.1, 9030.2, 9030.3, 9030.4 and 9030.5), are hereby
5 repealed.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
