6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Commissioner of Public Safety;
8 requiring the Commissioner to provide for a study for
9 certain purposes; stating what the study shall be
10 based on; stating what the study shall include;
11 requiring a certain report; providing for
12 noncodificaton; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 A. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall provide for a study
17 on the development and implementation of a web-based online
18 permitting and routing system for all oversized and overweight
19 vehicles.

20 B. The study shall be based on the system implemented in Texas
21 in 2011. The study shall include, but not be limited to, a cost
22 analysis for implementation and maintenance of the system, the
23 required coordination with any other state agencies in executing the
24 requirements of permitting and routing for oversized and overweight

1 vehicles and any potential private contracting required for software
2 needs.

3 C. A comprehensive report outlining a plan to implement a web-
4 based online permitting and routing system for all oversized and
5 overweight vehicles shall be submitted to the President Pro Tempore
6 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by
7 December 1, 2012.

8 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
