6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Feral Swine Control Act;
8 amending 2 O.S. 2011, Sections 6-608 and 6-609, which
9 relate to feral swine; modifying importation
10 requirements for live feral swine; modifying
11 transport destinations of live feral swine; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-608, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 6-608. A. ~~Any~~ No person ~~importing~~ shall import live
17 feral swine into this state ~~shall be~~ unless the live feral swine are
18 going directly to a slaughter facility in a sealed trailer and
19 accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an
20 accredited veterinarian that contains the following:

21 ~~1. A written entry permit approved by the State Veterinarian or~~
22 ~~chief animal health official of the state of origin;~~

23 ~~2. Individual identification of each feral swine; and~~

24 ~~3. Negative brucellosis and pseudorabies test results~~ USDA vs
1-27 permit for the movement of restricted animals.

1 B. ~~A person shall obtain a negative brucellosis and~~
2 ~~pseudorabies test within fifteen (15) days prior to entry.~~

3 C. ~~All live feral swine imported into this state shall be~~
4 ~~quarantined and isolated to retest for brucellosis and pseudorabies.~~
5 ~~The testing shall be conducted no earlier than thirty (30) days and~~
6 ~~no later than sixty (60) days following the date of importation,~~
7 ~~except for feral swine going directly to an approved slaughter~~
8 ~~facility.~~

9 D. All feral swine in this state that test positive for
10 brucellosis or pseudorabies shall be immediately sent directly to
11 slaughter or slaughtered on the premises pursuant to an order issued
12 by the State Veterinarian.

13 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-609, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 6-609. A. The State Board of Agriculture shall
16 promulgate rules for the testing and intrastate movement of live
17 feral swine.

18 B. All persons that transport live feral swine in this state
19 shall be required to obtain a transporter license from the Oklahoma
20 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

21 C. Live feral swine shall only be transported to the following:

- 22 1. A licensed sporting facility;
- 23 2. A licensed ~~breeding~~ handling facility;
- 24 3. ~~A licensed buying station;~~

1 ~~4. A licensed gathering station;~~

2 ~~5. Directly to an approved market or slaughter facility; or~~

3 ~~6.~~ 4. Pursuant to an order issued by the State Veterinarian.

4 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
