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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the State Capitol; amending 74
8 O.S. 2011, Section 410t, which relates to the Capitol
9 Architect and Curator; modifying duties of Capitol
10 Architect and Curator; modifying entity responsible
11 for contracting with or employing Capitol Architect
12 and Curator; requiring plan for renovation and
13 reconstruction of State Capitol; requiring
14 cooperation of certain entities; creating State
15 Capitol Renovation and Maintenance Revolving Fund;
16 providing for deposits thereto and expenditures
17 therefrom; providing for codification; providing an
18 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 4105, is
21 amended to read as follows:

22 Section 4105. A. There is hereby established the position of
23 the Capitol Architect and Curator who shall:

24 1. Develop the technical plans and programs for consideration
by the Legislature, the Governor and the State Capitol Preservation
Commission with regard to restoration, renovation, and preservation
of the Capitol and the Governor's Mansion; ~~and~~

1 2. Develop and enforce standards adopted for acquisition and
2 display of works of art in and surrounding the Capitol and the
3 Governor's Mansion; ~~and~~

4 3. Coordinate space demands of the various agencies in the
5 Capitol and the Governor's Mansion; ~~and~~

6 4. Maintain a record of all structural and decor changes made
7 in the Capitol and the Governor's Mansion; and

8 5. Make recommendations to the Legislature, the Governor and
9 the Commission of necessary action on proposed modifications in
10 decor or design to ensure preservation and maintenance of the
11 cultural and historic integrity of the Capitol and the Governor's
12 Mansion.

13 ~~The Director of Public Affairs may~~ Legislative Service Bureau
14 shall contract for the services of a Capitol Architect and Curator
15 or employ such an individual on either a full- or part-time basis.
16 Compensation for the position will be in accord with similar
17 professional positions in state government.

18 B. In addition to the duties set forth in subsection A of this
19 section, it shall be the duty of the Capitol Architect and Curator
20 to develop a plan for renovation and reconstruction of the Capitol
21 to be completed in time for celebration of the 100th anniversary of
22 completion of the State Capitol Building in 2017. The Capitol
23 Architect and Curator shall consult with the Governor, the President
24 Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives or such members as may be designated thereby, and
2 with other tenants of the Capitol building, to determine the needs
3 for and scope of renovation and reconstruction. The Capitol
4 Architect and Curator shall submit a plan to the Governor, the
5 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
6 Representatives not later than December 31, 2012, which shall
7 include the estimated costs of and estimated schedule for renovation
8 and reconstruction.

9 C. The State Capitol Preservation Commission, the Division of
10 Central Services of the Office of State Finance and all tenants of
11 the Capitol building are hereby directed to cooperate with and
12 provide such assistance to the Capitol Architect and Curator as may
13 be necessary.

14 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 452.16 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
18 for the Legislative Service Bureau to be designated the "State
19 Capitol Renovation and Maintenance Revolving Fund". The fund shall
20 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and
21 shall consist of all monies received by the Bureau from funds
22 designated for deposit thereto. All monies accruing to the credit
23 of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended
24 by the Bureau for the purpose of making expenditures related to

1 renovation and maintenance of the State Capitol. Expenditures from
2 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
3 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State
4 Finance for approval and payment.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
