8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to energy; amending 52 O.S. 2011,  
10 Section 207, which relates to the Interstate Oil  
11 Compact Commission; updating statutory language;  
12 authorizing maintenance of certain Oklahoma Energy  
13 Initiative; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 52 O.S. 2011, Section 207, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 207. A. There is hereby created in the Office of the  
18 State Treasurer a special fund to be known as "The Interstate Oil  
19 Compact Fund of Oklahoma". All monies accruing to ~~said~~ the fund are  
20 hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying the compensation of  
21 the assistant representative referred to in Section 205 of this  
22 title, the compensation of such clerical, technical, and legal  
23 assistants as he or she, with the consent of the Governor, may  
24 employ, the actual and necessary traveling expenses of the assistant

1 representative and his or her employees and of the Governor when  
2 traveling in his or her capacity as official representative of this  
3 state on "The Interstate Oil Compact Commission", all items of  
4 office expense including the cost of office supplies and equipment,  
5 such contributions as the Governor shall deem proper to pay to The  
6 Interstate Oil Compact Commission to defray its expenses, ~~and~~ such  
7 other necessary expenses as may be incurred in enabling this state  
8 to fully cooperate in accomplishing the objects of "The Interstate  
9 Compact to Conserve Oil and Gas".

10 B. The maintenance of the ~~Bartlesville Energy Research Center~~  
11 ~~at Bartlesville, Oklahoma,~~ Oklahoma Energy Initiative is hereby  
12 declared to be a part of the accomplishment of the objects of The  
13 Interstate Compact to Conserve Oil and Gas and the Governor is  
14 hereby authorized to contract with appropriate entities for such  
15 purposes and to pay the obligations thereof from the fund created by  
16 this section.

17 C. ~~Said~~ The fund shall be disbursed upon warrants issued by the  
18 State Treasurer upon sworn itemized claims approved by ~~said~~ the  
19 assistant representative and the Governor. If at the end of any  
20 fiscal year any part of ~~said~~ the special fund shall remain  
21 unexpended or unobligated, such balance shall be transferred by the  
22 State Treasurer to and become a part of the General Revenue Fund of  
23 the state for the ensuing fiscal year.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
