6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to entities that perform abortions or
8 maintain facilities that perform abortions;
9 prohibiting state entities from entering into
10 contracts or making grants to certain entities;
11 prohibiting certain appropriations to pay for
12 specified contracts or grants; directing the Office
13 of State Finance to determine that certain funds are
14 not available; providing for certain exemptions;
15 providing for codification; and providing an
16 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-741.1a of Title 63, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. An agency or other entity of the state shall not enter into
22 a contract with or make a grant to any entity that performs
23 abortions or maintains or operates a facility where abortions are
24 performed that involves the expenditure of state funds or federal
funds administered by the state.

B. Any appropriation by the state, including, but not limited
to, state appropriations of federal funds pursuant to any federal

1 law, to pay for a contract with or a grant made to any entity that
2 performs abortions or maintains or operates a facility where
3 abortions are performed is cancelled, and the money appropriated is
4 not available for payment of any contract with or grant made to the
5 entity that performs abortions or maintains or operates a facility
6 where abortions are performed.

7 C. For any contract with or grant made to an entity that
8 performs abortions or maintains or operates a facility where
9 abortions are performed as specified in subsection A of this
10 section, the Office of State Finance shall make a determination that
11 funds are not available and the contract or grant shall be
12 terminated.

13 D. This section shall not apply to hospitals or ambulatory
14 surgical centers licensed by the state.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
