6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making it  
8 unlawful to cut or damage a fence used for certain  
9 purposes; providing penalties; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1791 of Title 21, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any person who maliciously and knowingly cuts or damages a fence  
16 used for the production or containment of cattle, bison, horses,  
17 sheep, swine, goats, domestic fowl, exotic livestock, exotic  
18 poultry, exotic livestock or any game animals or domesticated game  
19 such that there is a loss or damage to such property is guilty of a  
20 felony.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
