6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school curriculum; approving
8 sporting clays as a permitted elective; providing
9 definition; providing an effective date; and
10 declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.12 of Title 70, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. A school district may offer to students in grade nine or
17 above an elective course on sporting clays.

18 B. For purposes of this act "sporting clays" is defined as the
19 competitive shooting of flying targets, known as clay pigeons, with
20 a shotgun or other firearm on a designed course.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
