6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma License and Vehicle
8 Registration Act; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Sections
9 1113, 1135.3 and 1135.5, which relate to license
10 plates; deleting requirement for inclusion of
11 certain emblem; providing exception to certain
12 requirement for design; requiring reissue of certain
13 special license plates based on specified dates of
14 authorization; limiting availability of certain
15 plates; providing for redesign of reissued plates;
16 authorizing Oklahoma Tax Commission to promulgate
17 rules and to use alternative inventory management;
18 providing exception to authority to renew special
19 plates; deleting authorization for various special
20 plates; providing for codification; and providing an
21 effective date.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1113, is
24 amended to read as follows:

25 Section 1113. A. 1. Except for all-terrain vehicles, utility
26 vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively off roads and highways,
27 upon the filing of a registration application and the payment of the
28 fees provided for in the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration
29 Act, the Oklahoma Tax Commission or Corporation Commission, as

1 applicable, shall assign to the vehicle described in the application
2 a distinctive number, and issue to the owner of the vehicle a
3 certificate of registration, one license plate and a yearly decal.
4 The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall assign an all-terrain vehicle,
5 utility vehicle or motorcycle used exclusively off roads and
6 highways a distinctive number and issue to the owner a certificate
7 of registration and a decal but not a license plate. For each
8 subsequent registration year, the Tax Commission shall issue a
9 yearly decal to be affixed to the license plate, except for an all-
10 terrain vehicle, utility vehicle or motorcycle used exclusively off
11 roads and highways. The initial decal for an all-terrain vehicle,
12 utility vehicle or motorcycle shall be attached to the front of the
13 vehicle and shall be in clear view. The decal shall be on the front
14 or on the front fork of the motorcycle used exclusively off roads
15 and highways and the decal shall be in clear view. The yearly decal
16 shall have an identification number and the last two numbers of the
17 registration year for which it shall expire. Except as provided by
18 Section 1113A of this title, the license plate shall be affixed to
19 the exterior of the vehicle until a replacement license plate is
20 applied for. If the owner applies for a replacement license plate,
21 the Tax Commission shall charge the fee provided for in Section 1114
22 of this title. The yearly decal will validate the license plate for
23 each registration period other than the year the license plate is
24 issued. The license plate and decal shall be of such size, color,

1 design and numbering as the Tax Commission may direct. However,
2 yearly decals issued to the owner of a vehicle who has filed an
3 affidavit with the appropriate motor license agent in accordance
4 with Section 7-607 of this title shall be a separate and distinct
5 color from all other decals issued under this section. The Tax
6 Commission shall also issue a monthly decal which shall include a
7 two-letter abbreviation corresponding to the county in which the
8 vehicle is registered. The Tax Commission is hereby directed to
9 develop the decal design to incorporate these requirements in a
10 manner that will permit county abbreviation to be readily
11 identified. The Tax Commission shall develop a unique two-letter
12 abbreviation for each county to be used on the decals. The Tax
13 Commission shall issue all decals in the possession of the Tax
14 Commission on January 1, 2010, prior to issuing any of the county
15 abbreviation decals created pursuant to this paragraph.

16 2. The license plate shall be securely attached to the rear of
17 the vehicle, except truck-tractor plates which shall be attached to
18 the front of the vehicle. The Tax Commission may, with the
19 concurrence of the Department of Public Safety, by Joint Rule,
20 change and direct the manner, place and location of display of any
21 vehicle license plate when such action is deemed in the public
22 interest. The license plate, decal and all letters and numbers
23 shall be clearly visible at all times. The operation of a vehicle
24 in this state, regardless of where such vehicle is registered, upon

1 which the license plate is covered, overlaid or otherwise screened
2 with any material, whether such material be clear, translucent,
3 tinted or opaque, shall be a violation of this paragraph.

4 3. Upon payment of the annual registration fee provided in
5 Section 1133 of this title, the Tax Commission or Corporation
6 Commission, as applicable, or a motor license agent may issue a
7 permanent nonexpiring license plate to an owner of one hundred or
8 more commercial motor vehicles and for vehicles registered under the
9 provisions of Section 1120 of this title. Upon payment of the
10 annual registration fee, the Tax Commission or Corporation
11 Commission shall issue a certificate of registration that shall be
12 carried at all times in the vehicle for which it is issued.
13 Provided, if the registrant submits its application through
14 electronic means, such qualified owners of one hundred or more
15 commercial motor vehicles, properly registered pursuant to the
16 provisions of Section 1133 of this title, may elect to receive a
17 permanent certificate of registration that shall be carried at all
18 times in the vehicle for which it is issued.

19 4. Every vehicle owned by an agency of this state shall be
20 exempt from the payment of registration fees required by this title.
21 Provided, such vehicle shall be registered and shall otherwise
22 comply with the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
23 Registration Act.

24

1 B. The license plates required under the provisions of this
2 title shall conform to the requirements and specifications listed
3 hereinafter:

4 1. Each license plate shall have a space for the placement of
5 the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the
6 initial issue;

7 2. The provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
8 Registration Act regarding the issuance of yearly decals shall not
9 apply to the issuance of apportioned license plates, including
10 license plates for state vehicles, and exempt plates for
11 governmental entities and fire departments organized pursuant to
12 Section 592 of Title 18 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 3. Within the limits herein prescribed the Tax Commission shall
14 redesign the official vehicle license plates which currently bear
15 the legend "Oklahoma OK" or "Oklahoma is OK!" and substitute
16 therefor the legend "Oklahoma Native America" as further described
17 in this paragraph. ~~Except for personalized license plates and~~
18 ~~license plates issued for motorcycles and mopeds, the emblem on the~~
19 ~~state flag of Oklahoma as provided for in Section 91 of Title 25 of~~
20 ~~the Oklahoma Statutes shall be a part of all license plates issued~~
21 ~~after December 31, 1988.~~ The Tax Commission may continue to issue
22 license plates with the legend "Oklahoma is OK!" or "Oklahoma OK"
23 until any inventory of such license plates is depleted but the Tax
24 Commission shall not produce or cause to be produced any additional

1 license plates with these legends. Except for personalized license
2 plates, license plates issued for commercial vehicles, and license
3 plates issued for motorcycles and mopeds, the "Oklahoma Native
4 America" emblem shall be a part of all license plates issued after
5 December 31, 1993. The specifications for lettering style and
6 appearance for the legend "Oklahoma Native America" shall be
7 provided to the Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and
8 Recreation Department. All license plates and decals shall be made
9 with reflectorized material as a background to the letters, numbers
10 and characters displayed thereon. The reflectorized material shall
11 be of such a nature as to provide effective and dependable
12 brightness during the service period for which the license plate or
13 decal is issued;

14 4. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Tax
15 Commission shall design appropriate official license plates for all
16 state vehicles. Such license plates shall be permanent in nature
17 and designed in such manner as to remain with the vehicle for the
18 duration of the vehicle's life span or until the title is
19 transferred to a nongovernmental owner;

20 5. Within the limits prescribed in this section, the Tax
21 Commission shall design appropriate official license plates for
22 vehicles of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plates shall
23 have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain the letters "OHP"
24 followed by the state seal and the badge number of the Highway

1 Patrol officer to whom the vehicle is assigned. The words "Oklahoma
2 Highway Patrol" shall also be included on such license plates;

3 6. Within the limits prescribed in this section, the Tax
4 Commission shall design appropriate official license plates for
5 vehicles of the Oklahoma Military Department. Such license plates
6 shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain the letters
7 "OMD" followed by the state seal and three numbers or letters as
8 designated by the Adjutant General. The words "Oklahoma Military
9 Department" shall also be included on such license plates; and

10 7. ~~Within~~ Except as provided in Section 2 of this act and
11 within the limits prescribed in this section, the Oklahoma Tourism
12 and Recreation Department shall design any license plates required
13 by the initiation of a license plate reissuance by the Oklahoma Tax
14 Commission at the request of the Department of Public Safety
15 pursuant to the provisions of Section ~~1 of this act~~ 1113.2 of this
16 title. Any such new designs shall be submitted by the Oklahoma
17 Tourism and Recreation Department to the Department of Public Safety
18 for its approval prior to being issued by the Oklahoma Tax
19 Commission.

20 C. Where the applicant has satisfactorily shown that the
21 applicant owns the vehicle sought to be registered but is unable to
22 produce documentary evidence of the ownership, a license plate may
23 be issued upon approval by the Tax Commission or Corporation
24 Commission, as applicable. In such instances the reason for not

1 issuing a certificate of title shall be indicated on the receipt
2 given to the applicant. It shall still be the duty of the applicant
3 to immediately take all necessary steps to obtain the Oklahoma
4 certificate of title and it shall be unlawful for the applicant to
5 sell the vehicle until the certificate has been obtained in the
6 applicant's name.

7 D. The certificate of registration provided for in this section
8 shall be in convenient form, and the certificate of registration, or
9 a certified copy or photostatic copy thereof, duly authenticated by
10 the Tax Commission or Corporation Commission, as applicable, shall
11 be carried at all times in or upon commercial vehicles so
12 registered, in such manner as to permit a ready examination thereof
13 upon demand by any peace officer of the state or duly authorized
14 employee of the Department of Public Safety. Any such officer or
15 agent may seize and hold such commercial vehicle when the operator
16 of the same does not have the registration certificate in the
17 operator's possession or when any such officer or agent determines
18 that the registration certificate has been obtained by
19 misrepresentation of any essential or material fact or when any
20 number or identifying information appearing on such certificate has
21 been changed, altered, obliterated or concealed in any way, until
22 the proper registration or identification of such vehicle has been
23 made or produced by the owner thereof.

24

1 E. The purchaser of a new or used manufactured home shall,
2 within thirty (30) days of the date of purchase, register the home
3 with the Tax Commission or a motor license agent pursuant to the
4 provisions of Section 1117 of this title. For a new manufactured
5 home, it shall be the responsibility of the dealer selling the home
6 to place a temporary license plate on the home in the same manner as
7 provided in Section 1128 of this title for other new motor vehicles.
8 For the first year that any manufactured home is registered in this
9 state, the Tax Commission shall issue a metal license plate which
10 shall be affixed to the manufactured home. The temporary dealer
11 license plate or the metal license plate shall be displayed on the
12 manufactured home at all times when upon a public roadway; provided,
13 a repossession affidavit issued pursuant to Sections 1110 and 1126
14 of this title shall be permissible in lieu of a current license
15 plate and decal for the purposes of removing a repossessed
16 manufactured home to a secure location. Manufactured homes
17 previously registered and subject to ad valorem taxation as provided
18 by law shall have a decal affixed at the time ad valorem taxes are
19 paid for such manufactured home; provided, for a manufactured home
20 permanently affixed to real estate, no decal or license plate shall
21 be required to be affixed and the owner thereof shall be given a
22 receipt upon payment of ad valorem taxes due on the home. The Tax
23 Commission shall make sufficient plates and decals available to the
24 various motor license agents of the state in order for an owner of a

1 manufactured home to acquire the plate or decal. A one-dollar fee
2 shall be charged for issuance of any plate or decal. The fee shall
3 be apportioned each month to the General Revenue Fund of the State
4 Treasury.

5 F. The decal shall be easily visible for purposes of
6 verification by a county assessor that the manufactured home is
7 properly assessed for ad valorem taxation. In the first year of
8 registration, a decal shall be issued for placement on the license
9 plate indicating payment of applicable registration fees and excise
10 taxes. A duplicate manufactured home registration decal shall be
11 affixed inside the window nearest the front door of the manufactured
12 home. In the second and all subsequent years for which the
13 manufactured home is subject to ad valorem taxation, an annual decal
14 shall be affixed inside the window nearest the front door as
15 evidence of payment of ad valorem taxes. The Tax Commission shall
16 issue decals to the various county treasurers of the state in order
17 for a manufactured home owner to obtain such decal each year. Upon
18 presentation of a valid ad valorem tax receipt, the manufactured
19 home owner shall be issued the annual decal.

20 G. Upon the registration of a manufactured home in this state
21 for the first time or upon discovery of a manufactured home
22 previously registered within this state for which the information
23 required by this subsection is not known, the Tax Commission shall
24 obtain:

- 1 1. The name of the owner of the manufactured home;
- 2 2. The serial number or identification number of the
- 3 manufactured home;
- 4 3. A legal description or address of the location for the home;
- 5 4. The actual retail selling price of the manufactured home
- 6 excluding Oklahoma taxes;
- 7 5. The certificate of title number for the home; and
- 8 6. Any other information which the Tax Commission deems to be
- 9 necessary.

10 The application for registration shall also include the school
11 district in which the manufactured home is located or is to be
12 located. The information shall be entered into a computer data
13 system which shall be used by the Tax Commission to provide
14 information to county assessors upon request by the assessor. The
15 assessor may request any information from the system in order to
16 properly assess a manufactured home for ad valorem taxation.

17 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1113.4 of Title 47, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. For any special license plate first authorized before
21 January 1, 2004 and provided for in Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5 of
22 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Administrator of the Oklahoma
23 Tax Commission shall initiate a reissue of such plate if five
24

1 hundred (500) or more applications for the plate were received by
2 the Tax Commission during calendar year 2013.

3 B. For any special license plate first authorized after January
4 1, 2004 and provided for in Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5 of Title 47
5 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Administrator of the Oklahoma Tax
6 Commission shall initiate a reissue of such special license plate
7 ten (10) years after the date of first authorization, if five
8 hundred (500) or more applications for the plate were received by
9 the Tax Commission during the preceding calendar year.

10 C. Any special plate which is not reissued pursuant to
11 subsections A and B of this section shall no longer be available
12 after the reissue period.

13 D. Any special plate which is reissued pursuant to this section
14 shall be redesigned to include a distinguishing feature which
15 clearly signifies that the plate has been reissued but does not
16 interfere with the original design or logo of the special plate.

17 E. The Tax Commission shall have the authority to promulgate
18 any rules necessary to implement a reissuance of special plates. In
19 conjunction with a reissue, the Oklahoma Tax Commission and the
20 Oklahoma Correctional Industries may utilize an alternative method
21 of license plate inventory management.

22 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24

1 Section 1135.3. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
3 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
4 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
5 subject as provided by this section.

6 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
7 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
8 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
9 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
10 registered for the current year.

11 ~~Special~~ Except as provided in Section 2 of this act, special
12 license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a
13 motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by
14 mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall
15 contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for
16 the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or
17 the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a
18 staggered system.

19 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
20 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
21 applications for special license plates authorized under this
22 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
23 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
24 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary

1 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
2 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
3 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
4 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
5 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

7 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
8 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
9 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
10 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
11 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
12 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
13 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
14 removed from the vehicle.

15 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
16 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
17 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
18 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
19 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
20 Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the effective
21 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
22 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
23 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
24 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
2 follows:

3 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 round and square dancing;

6 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
7 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
8 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
9 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

10 3. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates
11 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
12 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
13 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
14 Association;

15 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
17 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
18 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
19 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
20 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
21 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
22 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
24 contain the Masonic emblem;

1 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
2 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
3 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
4 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
5 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
7 contain the Shriner's emblem;

8 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
9 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
10 ballooning in this state;

11 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
13 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
14 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
15 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
16 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
17 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
18 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
19 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
20 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

21 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
23 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
24 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
2 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
3 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
4 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
5 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
6 Columbus emblem;

7 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
8 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
9 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

11 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
13 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
14 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
15 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

16 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
18 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
19 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with Kiwanis International;

21 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
23 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
24 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated

1 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
2 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
3 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
4 Accountants;

5 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
7 support for the state civil emergency management system;

8 ~~14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates~~
9 ~~shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax~~
10 ~~Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and~~
11 ~~issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian~~
12 ~~Conservation Corps;~~

13 ~~15.~~ Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
14 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
15 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
16 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
17 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
18 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
19 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
20 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
21 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

22 ~~16.~~ 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks - such plates shall
23 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
24 Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and issued

1 to any resident of this state who is a member of the Benevolent
2 Protective Order of Elks;

3 ~~17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be~~
4 ~~designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for~~
5 ~~the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued~~
6 ~~to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to~~
7 ~~a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate~~
8 ~~shall contain the official Humane Society logo;~~

9 ~~18.~~ 16. Oklahoma Mustang Club - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, by the
11 Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this state who
12 is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons may apply
13 for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon presentment of proof
14 of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club. The plates shall be
15 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
16 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates;

17 ~~19.~~ 17. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
19 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
20 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with American Business Clubs;

22 ~~20.~~ 18. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
24 commemorate the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the

1 United States Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license
2 plates shall be designed in consultation with the West Point Society
3 of Central Oklahoma;

4 ~~21. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be~~
5 ~~designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for~~
6 ~~the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in~~
7 ~~consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;~~

8 ~~22. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plates - such plates~~
9 ~~shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate~~
10 ~~support for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates~~

6 the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or
7 the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a
8 staggered system.

9 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
10 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
11 applications for special license plates authorized under this
12 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
13 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount

5 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
6 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
7 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
8 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
9 the Tax Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the
10 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
11 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are

8 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
9 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
10 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
11 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
12 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle

12 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
14 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
15 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
16 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
17 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
18 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
19 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
