5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to school administration; creating
7 the Task Force on Creating Administrative
8 Efficiencies; stating duties; providing for
9 membership, appointment, designation of officers,
10 quorum and staff support; prohibiting compensation
and reimbursement; requiring report of findings and
recommendations; providing for noncodification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 A. There is hereby created until November 30, 2012, the Task
16 Force on Creating Administrative Efficiencies for the purpose of
17 improving efficiency and reducing duplicative overhead costs. The
18 task force shall examine ways to reduce administrative costs and the
19 impact of such cost reductions on school district operations and
20 student learning.

21 B. The task force shall consist of members appointed pursuant
22 to Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 536 of the 1st Session of
23 the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, unless the appointing authority
24 provides a replacement.

1 C. The Chair of the Senate Education Committee shall designate
2 the chair of the task force. Any appointments replacing members of
3 the task force shall be made by August 31, 2012. Meetings of the
4 task force shall be held at the call of the chair of the task force.
5 Members shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing authorities.
6 A majority of the members of the task force shall constitute a
7 quorum to transact business, but no vacancy shall impair the right
8 of the remaining members to exercise all of the powers of the task
9 force. A vacancy on the task force shall be filled by the original
10 appointing authority. Staff support for the task force shall be
11 provided by the State Department of Education, the Senate, and the
12 House of Representatives.

13 D. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or
14 travel reimbursement for serving on the task force.

15 E. The task force shall submit a report of findings and
16 recommendations to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the
17 Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
