6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to wreckers and towing services;  
8 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 964, which relates to  
9 certain report of vehicles parked or stored;  
10 clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 964, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 964. Whenever a vehicle that is subject to registration  
15 in this state has been stored, parked or left in a garage, trailer  
16 park, or any type of storage or parking lot for a period of thirty  
17 (30) days, the owner of the garage, trailer park or lot shall,  
18 within five (5) days after the expiration of that period, report the  
19 make, motor and serial number of the vehicle to the Department of  
20 Public Safety. Provided, these provisions shall not apply where  
21 arrangements have been made for continuous storage or parking by the  
22 owner of the motor vehicle so parked or stored, and where the owner  
23 of said motor vehicle so parked or stored is personally known to the  
24 owner or operator of the garage, trailer park, storage or parking

1 lot. Any person who fails to report a vehicle as required under  
2 this section shall forfeit all claims for storage of the vehicle,  
3 and shall be subject to a fine ~~not to exceed~~ no more than Twenty-  
4 five Dollars (\$25.00), and each day's failure to make a report as  
5 required by this section shall constitute a separate offense.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.

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
