6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to electronic information; amending
8 75 O.S. 2011, Section 14, which relates to copies of
9 statutes and session laws; providing that certain
10 persons may receive electronic or digital copies of
11 statutes and session laws; allowing such persons to
12 request printed copies in lieu thereof; and declaring
13 an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2011, Section 14, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 14. A. The following officers shall be entitled to
18 receive as soon as available from the state without cost electronic
19 or digital copies of the ~~printed volumes of the~~ statutes and session
20 laws of the state published or purchased by the Legislature, or
21 under its authority, for distribution:

22 1. Each state officer, including the Governor and Lieutenant
23 Governor, the chief administrative officers and assistants of state
24 departments, boards, and commissions, upon written application and
request submitted to the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma

1 House of Representatives, within sixty (60) days of January 1 of
2 each year, and said volumes shall be distributed at the discretion
3 of the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma House of
4 Representatives; ~~and~~

5 2. Each member of the Legislature; ~~and~~

6 3. The Justices of the Supreme Court and the Judges of the
7 Court of Criminal Appeals, and the clerk of said Courts; ~~and~~

8 4. The chief administrative officers of the state educational,
9 benevolent, and penal institutions; ~~and~~

10 5. The judges of the district courts and district court clerks;
11 ~~and~~

12 6. County clerks; ~~and~~

13 7. County treasurers; ~~and~~

14 8. County assessors; ~~and~~

15 9. District attorneys and one assistant district attorney in
16 each county; ~~and~~

17 10. Sheriffs; ~~and~~

18 11. All members of the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation; and

19 12. Each library association organized in any county, city, or
20 town in this state for the benefit of the public.

21 B. Fifty-five (55) electronic or digital copies of the statutes
22 and session laws shall be furnished to the law library of the
23 College of Law of the University of Oklahoma, five copies to be kept
24 for use therein and fifty copies for purposes of exchange.

1 C. Five (5) electronic or digital copies of the statutes and
2 session laws shall be placed in the library of Oklahoma State
3 University at Stillwater, Oklahoma, for use therein.

4 D. One hundred ten (110) electronic or digital copies of the
5 statutes and session laws shall be furnished to the Oklahoma
6 Department of Libraries for its use and exchange purposes.

7 E. The Chief Clerk-Administrator may, ~~in his discretion,~~
8 furnish ~~from any~~ digital or electronic copies of such laws ~~on hand~~
9 to state officers other than those specified in this section for the
10 use of their offices.

11 F. Any person or entity entitled to receive digital or
12 electronic copies of statutes or session laws as provided in this
13 section may request printed copies in lieu of such digital or
14 electronic copies.

15 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
