6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Department of Mental Health and
8 Substance Abuse Services training schools; amending
9 43A O.S. 2001, Section 2-214, which relates to
10 training schools within the Department of Mental
11 Health and Substance Abuse Services; making language
12 gender-neutral; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2001, Section 2-214, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2-214. The Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance
17 Abuse Services is authorized to establish training schools within
18 the Department or within any of the institutions operated by the
19 Department, for the training of necessary personnel for the
20 institutions, or may arrange for the training of employees or
21 prospective employees in any public or private school or institution
22 within this state or elsewhere having available facilities for that
23 purpose. Funds of the Department and/or institutions under its
24 control may be used to pay salaries to employees, or to pay tuition
and subsistence for employees or prospective employees, while

1 receiving such training. Any employee or prospective employee who
2 is paid a salary, or for whom tuition and subsistence are furnished,
3 while receiving such training, shall be required to enter into a
4 contract prior to receiving such training, that unless ~~he~~ the person
5 continues in the employ of the Department for at least a period
6 equivalent to the training, ~~he~~ such person will reimburse to the
7 Department the sum paid to or for ~~him~~ the person by the Department
8 during the period of ~~his~~ training.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
