7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
8 21 O.S. 2011, Section 142A-13, which relates to
9 granting of parole or pardon; modifying time period
for certain notification; and providing an effective
date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 142A-13, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 142A-13. A. Upon the granting of a parole by the
16 Governor, and release of the inmate to the community, the Pardon and
17 Parole Board shall provide written notification to any victim of the
18 crime for which the parolee was convicted by mailing the
19 notification to the last-known address of the victim, if such
20 information is requested by the victim. The Pardon and Parole Board
21 shall not give the address of the parolee to any victim of the crime
22 for which the parolee was convicted.

23 B. Upon the granting of a pardon by the Governor, the Pardon
24 and Parole Board shall provide written notification to any victim of

1 the crime for which the person receiving the pardon was convicted by
2 mailing the notification to the last-known address of the victim, if
3 such information is requested by the victim. The Pardon and Parole
4 Board shall not give the address of the person receiving the pardon
5 to any victim of the crime for which the person receiving the pardon
6 was convicted.

7 C. The notification shall be made on a monthly basis by the
8 ~~tenth day~~ first Monday of the month following the granting of the
9 pardon or parole.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.

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
